
## World Bank CDD-Local Economic Development (LED) Portfolio


## (Data retrieved from active CDD Projects as of June 30, 2019)

- As of end-June 2019, there were 116 active CDD-LED projects (including 8 Recipient-Executed projects and excluding Additional Financing projects) in 57 countries (45 of which are IDA or IDA-Blend with 25 in AFR), totaling approximately \$6.5 billion in Bank lending towards livelihoods or local economic development (LED) components<sup>1</sup> (77 percent of which is IDA).
- The CDD-LED active portfolio comprises approximately 30 percent of the Bank lending volume of the active CDD portfolio. Total CDD active project lending is \$21.7 billion in Bank funding (69 percent of which is IDA), to 222 active projects, (excluding 61 AF projects) in 79 countries (57 of which were IDA or IDA-Blend countries, with 32 in AFR).
- Regionally (and consistent with the CDD active portfolio), the CDD-LED lending portfolio is concentrated in Africa (\$2.6 billion) and South Asia (\$2.4 billion). Latin America is next with \$780 million, followed by East Asia (\$440 million), Europe and Central Asia (\$280 million) and Middle East and North Africa (\$21 million).



• Sectorally, the CDD-LED portfolio is dominated by the Agriculture Global Practice which has 82 percent of the Bank-funded lending portfolio (73 projects totaling \$5.3 billion). The balance is spread among Social Protection and Jobs (12 projects totaling \$470 million), Social, Urban and Rural (17 projects totaling \$350 million), Environment (12 projects totaling \$340 million) and Water (2 projects totaling \$43 million).

## CDD in Situations of Fragility, Conflict and Violence (FCV)

- As of end-June 2019, the CDD-LED portfolio in FCV situations totaled 26 projects with Bank lending of US\$561 million. The portfolio covers 12 countries (33 percent) on the FY19 Harmonized List of Fragile Situations, as well as four other countries where projects are addressing forced displacement or subnational conflict (e.g., Azerbaijan, Niger, Sierra Leone and Tajikistan).
- The CDD-LED FCV portfolio comprises 12 percent of the Bank lending volume of the active CDD-FCV portfolio (which is \$4.5 billion in Bank funding to 61 active projects in 36 countries).
- Africa has 84 percent of the active CDD-LED lending portfolio in FCV situations (\$472 million),
  consistent with the overall CDD-FCV portfolio. ECA has three projects totaling \$40 million, while
  the other regions each have one project (the MNA project in Yemen being trust funded and
  recipient-executed, with no Bank funding allocated).
