Calling all “Inn-OBA-tors!” The Global Partnership on Output-Based Aid is pleased to announce its third annual “Inn-OBA-tions” Awards competition, recognizing ...you guessed it: innovative and outstanding projects and teams using Output-Based Aid (OBA) and other Results-Based Financing (RBF) approaches.

In honor of year three of the Inn-OBA-tions Awards, GPOBA invites you to submit a proposal based on the following three categories:

PIONEER AWARD

To honor those who have dared to go where no project has gone before, including first-time pilots, cutting-edge design, and efforts in areas that have little or no previous OBA/RBF experience

COLLABORATION AWARD

For projects that exemplify the benefits of teamwork—leveraging partnerships within the World Bank Group, and/or with donors, governments, NGOs, and the private sector.

SOCIAL INCLUSION AWARD

To recognize work that includes the excluded. Projects which target and positively impact traditionally marginalized or disadvantaged groups, such as (but not limited to) indigenous peoples, women, refugees, or people with disabilities.

The competition is open to all projects that use results-based approaches to finance projects. A panel of reviewers will determine the winning proposals. Teams whose projects are chosen for an award will be recognized at a ceremony on **Wednesday, December 16, 2015**. The awards will be presented by Senior Director **Ede Ijjasz-Vasquez** from the Social, Urban, Rural, and Resilience Global Practice (GPSURR).
