


Previous site status of Roppongi Hills development











- March 1946** Construction of Loop Road No.2 was formally decided (length 9.2km, width 100m)
- March 1950** Revision of the width of Loop Road No.2 to 40m
- June 1989** Establishment of a system that allowed construction of facilities above and/or below roads
- December 1998** The urban area redevelopment project was formally decided
- June 2000** The urban area development project was revised (extension of the project area)
- May 2002** Selection of Mori Building / Nishimatsu Group firms for cooperation (through a public offer)
- October 2002** Urban area development project plan was formally decided
 - revised according to progress of the project plan--
- April 2007** Public notice for completion of Zone II construction (specified builder: Marubeni Corporation)
- September 2009** Mori Building was selected as the specified builder for Zone III (approved by Minister of MLIT)
- April 2011** Commencement of Zone III construction
- “** Public notice for completion of Zone I construction (specified builder: Nishimatsu Building Service)
- 2014** Public notice for completion of Zone III construction








Image of the vicinity of Toranomom New Station (tentative name)
