Key Takeaways from TDD



- 1. systematic approach to culture heritage conservation
- 2. Long-term planning, preparation and stakeholder engagement at early stage to ensure quality master plan, sector plan;
- 3. Highlight the importance to include private sector and local residents in cultural heritage conservation and promotion;
- 4. Integration of heritage conservation with tourism development and urban regeneration

- 1. Lacking of expertise and systematic approach to improve the quality of planning (needs technical and clinical assessment of the existing plans);
- 2. Lack of fund and expertise on cultural conservation, accessibility (roads, water & sanitation facilities) and destination promotion
- 3. Shifting from physical constructions esp. fancy and big size structures to "soft" construction; from chasing for short-term economic returns to long-term benefits;
- 4. An enabling environment to encourage private sector and individual resident be engaged in cultural conservation and urban regeneration is demanded(to establish a scientific and incentive mechanism for public and private collaboration /to create a reasonable and sustainable methodology of land transaction, etc.)
- 5. Insufficient institutional capacity



Actions to be Taken

• Short-term:

- Capacity building includes training on urban regeneration, heritage conservation, sustainable tourism; The activities can be delivered by both domestic and international experts under the world bank project;
- Oversea experiencing and brainstorming tour with respect to good practices of cultural conservation and urban regeneration for officials from project cities under the processing loan; world bank and TDLC can provide support on this regards;

• Medium-term:

- Technical assistance on clinical assessment of the existing plans (policy note) by a joint international expertise;
- Technical assistance on public and private collaboration mechanism development with consultation of all stakeholders and support from international and domestic expertise

• Long-term:

• Establish methodology for planning review and related regulations improvement by local government.
