

- After signing up online or via email, you will receive an account activation link via email. Click the link and login using your email address (not name) and password.





After your account is activated, you will **firstly** have to join the Community Manager Roundtable group by clicking the Join button on the right side and **after that** you can join the IUWM platform.

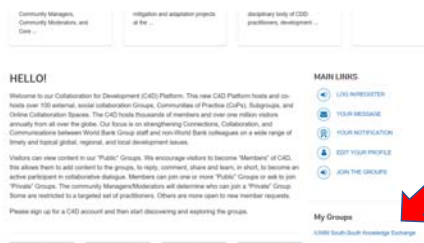
