






Figure : Shibuya Terminal Vicinity












Joint Operation by Tokyu Toyoko Line and Tokyo Metro Fukutoshin Line






Shibuya Station Town District Infrastructure Development Policy Left: Aerial View (current layout) / Right: Aerial View (image of future development)













Overview of Consensus-building Process
