

# What is Resilience?

Cities rely on a complex web of **systems** to perform essential functions including **institutions**, **infrastructure** and **information** systems

- City **systems** can be **physical** such as public infrastructure, private housing or ecosystems
- They can also be **processes** and **practices** such as rule of law, community cohesion, industry standards (labour, building codes) and emergency response procedures



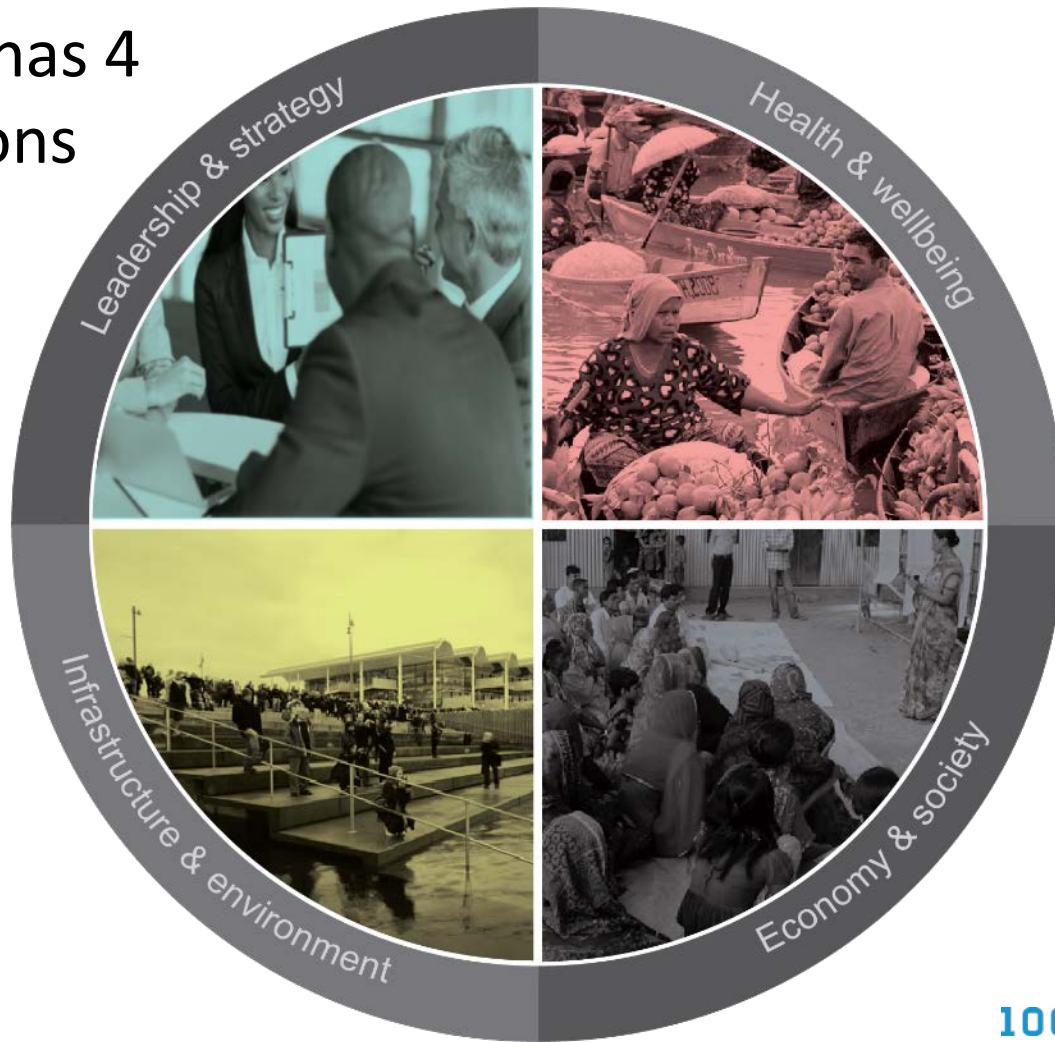
The more robust each individual **system** is the stronger the city is overall



## URBAN RESILIENCE

Is the capacity of individuals, communities, institutions, businesses, and systems within a city to survive, adapt, and grow no matter what kinds of chronic stresses and acute shocks they experience.

4. Membership in the **100RC NETWORK**

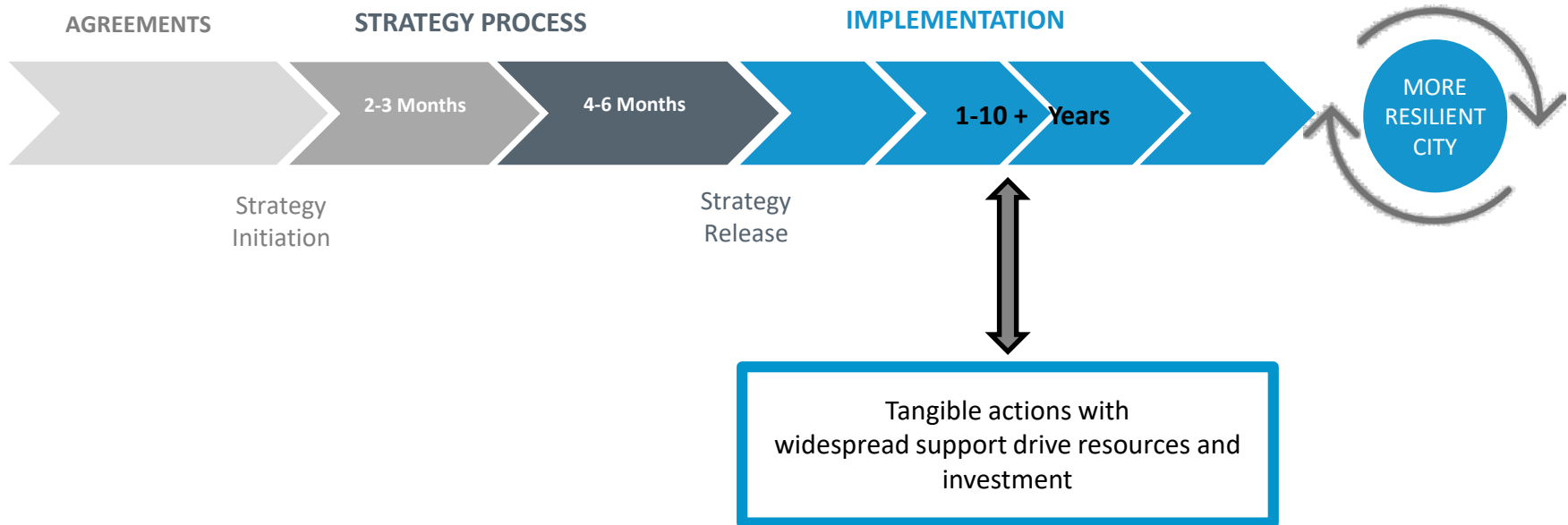
