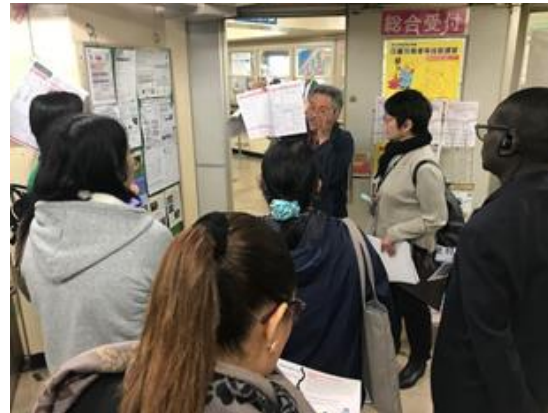

4. Community Participation and Consultation
5. Bottom up/ top down approach and decentralization
