Virtual Knowledge Exchange Program: Smart Cities for Climate Resilience



A virtual knowledge exchange program on "Smart Cities for Climate Resilience" was organized by the [Global Smart City Partnership Program](#) (GSCP) and the [Netherlands Enterprise Agency](#) on February 23-24, 2022. Two-day event had 60 participants from all around world including Egypt, Jordan, Mongolia, Turkey, Slovakia, South Africa, and Uganda. The objective of the Program was to promote knowledge sharing between the key stakeholders in the government, private society and academia from the Netherlands and the World Bank client countries on building smart cities for the future. The discussions focused on: (1) Showcasing Dutch expertise and sharing the planning, implementing initiatives that made smart city projects a success; (2) Facilitating interactive sessions where participants can share their experiences, knowledge; (3) Connecting the World Bank clients with different actors in the Netherlands in order to help them tackle their challenges in creating smart cities.
